Our Current Series; Shine: Beacons of Goodness and Light

Join us in our study of the prophet Isaiah and the theme of "light" in the book that bears his name.

This Morning: Isaiah 9:1-4: The Light of Revival

Every church has stories about a "golden age." When So-and-So was pastor and the church was growing. The cries of delighted children echoed through the corridors and the food at pot-luck meals stretched across five tables. Services always started on time, the choir was soaring and majestic, and the preacher never went past 12:00.

To some extent, this nostalgia is wonderful. It can be inspirational, spurring us on to return to the heights of the "good old days." We long for what we think of as "Revival." Getting back to where we once were.

Isaiah strikes a nostalgic note in today's' scripture passage, but as we unpack his message to God's people, we discover he has far more in mind than turning back the clock.

Vision: Lenses for Discipleship

The Sermon on the Mount is often called "the greatest sermon ever preached," but we seldom stop to think about its context. This sermon is preached very early in Jesus' ministry, right on the heels of his call to a handful of fishermen on the Sea of Galilee. It stands in Matthew's gospel as his first instructions to those who chose to follow him. Much of what he had to say is still reflected in our membership vows of "prayers, presence, gifts, service, and witness."

Today: Matthew 5:1-16

We come today to the central portion of Jesus' Sermon on the Mount: a section on what we do "in secret." At the center of this section is Jesus' teaching on prayer. At the center of this teaching is the Lord's prayer. At the center of this prayer is the petition "forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us."
